ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Asorphi Academy Higher Secondary School was established, under Asorphi a society registered under Meghalaya Societies Registration Act XII of 1983, in the year 2018 by a group of young energetic minds with the aim to establish, manage, maintain and run educational, vocational and technical education for the benefit of the rural student community that had been neglected for years. Asorphi Academy is more than just a school—it is a nurturing ground where young minds are shaped, talents are discovered, and dreams are nurtured.

Asorphi Academy Higher Secondary School is affiliated with the Meghalaya Board of School Education (MBOSE) and offers programs in the Arts and Science streams.

The journey of Asorphi Academy Higher Secondary School began in 2018 with just 25 students in the Science stream. What started as a small step of faith and commitment to education has now grown into a thriving institution with 201 students enrolled across both Arts and Science streams. The School holds a unique and vital position in the educational landscape of the Pynursla Civil Sub-Division. It is the only higher secondary institution in the entire sub-division that offers the Science stream, serving as a beacon of opportunity for students who aspire to pursue careers in medicine, engineering, technology, and other scientific fields. The Pynursla Civil Sub-Division encompasses 145 villages, many of which are in remote and rural areas with limited access to higher education. For students across these villages, Asorphi Academy stands as the only gateway to continuing their academic journey in Science without migrating to distant towns or cities.

Our growth has been matched by outstanding academic achievements. In 2024, the school proudly achieved 100% results in both Arts and Science in the HSSLC Examination conducted by the Meghalaya Board of School Education (MBOSE). The Arts section, introduced in 2021, has maintained a perfect record of 100% results every year since its inception.

School Week 2025



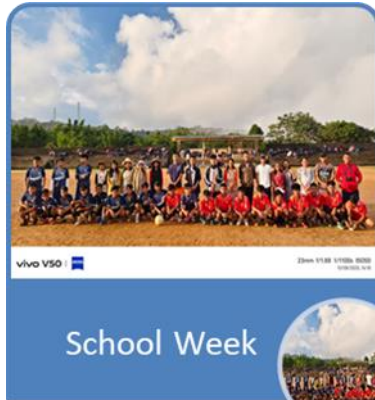

COMMUNICATION SKILLS

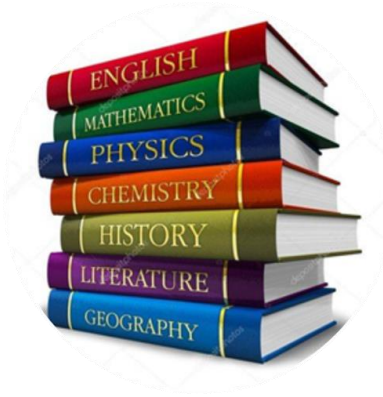
